6 Criteria:

1. Child abuse screen completed for all injured children with suspicious injury or history.
2. Height and weight documented within 10 minutes of arrival (Pediatric).
3. Full set of vitals included pain and GCS documented within ten minutes of arrival.(Pediatric)
(Activation specific)
4. Vascular access within 10 minutes of arrival (Pediatric). (Activation specific)
5. Resuscitation volume appropriate for weight and clinical status (Pediatric).
6. PECARN Guidelines utilized.
